Teaching Tips

1. Deliver a **10-min** lesson so pay attention to your pacing;
2. Keep **smiling** throughout the lesson;
3. Use **short sentences** and **simple words**;
4. Use at least **2 types of props**;
5. Use **TPR** frequently and consistently;
6. Offer lots of **guidance** and show lots of **patience**;
7. Use built-in and secondary **rewards** (pretend that you send a built-in reward);
8. Give **error correction** in a **positive manner**;
9. Encourage **student output** whenever possible;
10. **Do NOT skip** any teaching slides.

Ice-break:

1. Teacher (T) may welcome the student (S) to GOGOKID.
2. Teacher (T) may click the slide to introduce yourself.
3. Teacher (T) may click the slide to ask the student (S), "What's your name?" or "May I have your name?"
4. Teacher (T) may click the slide to say, "I am happy." and ask the student "How are you?" or "How old are you?"



Title:

1. T may talk about the information in the picture with "What is this?" or "What can you see in the picture?" (Jack, teddy bear, car, etc.)
2. T may say, "Today we'll talk about our faces. First, let's listen to a song."



What do you have?

P-Words:

1. T may click the slide to focus on Jack's eyes.
2. T may click the slide to introduce the word "eye," and S listens to the audio and repeats.
3. T may click the slide to introduce the plural form "eyes," and S listens to the audio and repeats.



T-Sentences: (Pay attention to the 'situation'.)

GOGOKID

1. T may click the slide to start the animation.
2. T may click the slide and ask S to listen to the audio.
3. S repeats the question.
4. T may click the slide again, and S repeats the answer.

What do you have?

I have two eyes.



T-sentences:

1. T may explain and demonstrate the task: read the sentence when the mic appears.
2. T may click the audio button, and S listens to the audio.
3. T may click the Start button, and S completes the task.
4. T may check the answer(s) and give feedback.

Listen and Say



Please pretend the student is able to read.



I have two eyes.

T-Letters:

1. T may click the slide and ask, "What letter is it?"
2. S listens to the audio and repeats.
3. S identifies the big A and the little a.



Student is distracted by a toy. Please help the student focus on the lesson.

T-Letters:

1. T may ask, "What letter is this?" (*This is the letter a.)
2. S identifies the big A and the little a.
3. S clicks the pencil and sees how to write the big A and the little a.
4. S practices writing with the pen tool.



Student does not understand the teacher's instructions to trace the letters.

Presentation:

1. T may practice the sentences with S. (*answer)
2. T may use the on-stage function and say, "Now it's your turn to do the presentation. Let's welcome (S's name) to the stage."
3. S appears on the slide and does the presentation independently.
4. T may check the answer(s) and give feedback.

What do you have?

DIY Song:

1. T may click the slide to play the music.
T may use the showtime feature to put him/herself on the stage.
2. S sings independently. (T may assist if needed.)
3. T may give feedback.

Let's Sing



1. T may give brief and warm feedback to the student.
2. T may use the "showtime" or "swap video" features and invite the student to join us.
3. This isn't the final slide, please check the next slide for further guidance.
